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INFORMED CONSENT FOR IN-PERSON SERVICES DURING COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH CRISIS

This document contains important information about our decision (yours and mine) to resume in-person training in light of the public health crisis. Please read this carefully and let me know if you have any questions. When you register for training, you are indicating that you agree to the below terms.

Decision to Meet Face to Face

You are agreeing to attend training in-person. If there is a resurgence of the pandemic or if other health concerns arise, I reserve the right to cancel training or move it to an online training. In the event that a training is cancelled or you do not wish to attend online, you may transfer to a future in-person training or receive a refund.

Risks of Opting for In-Person Services and Release of Liability

You understand that by coming to the training location, you are assuming the risk of exposure to the coronavirus or other public health risk and you agree to release and hold harmless me and the practice from any and all liability associated with such risk. This risk may increase if you travel by public transportation, taxi, or ridesharing service.

Your Responsibility to Minimize Your Exposure

To obtain training in person, you agree to take certain precautions which will help keep everyone (you, me, and our families, and other trainees and persons present in the training) safer from exposure, sickness and possible death. Your failure or refusal to adhere to these safeguards may result in removal from the training. You understand and agree to these actions:

- You will only keep your in-person registration if you are symptom free.
- You will take your temperature before coming to each training session. If it is elevated (100 Fahrenheit or more), or if you have other symptoms of the coronavirus, you agree to cancel and will be eligible for transfer or refund.
- You will wash your hands or use hand sanitizer either before or when you enter the training facility.
- You will adhere to the safe distancing precautions we have set up in the facility.
- You will wear a mask in all areas of the office (I and others in the facility will too).
- You will keep a distance of 6 feet and there will be no physical contact (e.g. no shaking hands) with me or with anyone in the facility.
- You will try not to touch your face or eyes with your hands. If you do, you will immediately wash or sanitize your hands.

- You will take steps prior to training to minimize your exposure.
- If a resident of your home tests positive for the infection, you will immediately let me know.

I may change the above precautions if additional local, state or federal orders or guidelines are published. If that happens, we will talk about any necessary changes.

My Commitment to Minimize Exposure

The training facility and I have taken steps to reduce the risk of spreading the virus within the facility.

If You or I Are Sick

You understand that I am committed to keeping you, me, others in the training, and all of our families safe from the spread of this virus. If you show up for a training and I believe that you have a fever or other symptoms, or believe you have been exposed, I will have to require you to leave the training immediately and you will be eligible for transfer or refund.

If I test positive for the coronavirus, I will notify you so that you can take appropriate precautions.

Your Confidentiality in the Case of Infection

If you have tested positive for the coronavirus, I may be required to notify local health authorities that you have been in the training.

Informed Consent

This agreement supplements to the general informed consent that you agree to in order to participate in training..

Your registration for training shows that you agree to these terms and conditions.
